## **JOB NOTICE**

The Kawartha Nordic Ski Club (KNSC) is a Nordic ski area located in North Kawartha township, Peterborough County, Ontario. Founded in 1976, Kawartha Nordic offers over 40 kilometres of groomed classic and skate trails, as well as 10 km of snowshoe trails through scenic, Canadian Shield wilderness. KNSC is a not-for-profit organization, governed by a volunteer board of directors, and offers numerous programs and events.

The Kawartha Nordic Ski Club (KNSC) is seeking applications for a Part-Time **Groomer** with the club. This is a contract position from December 2015 to March 2016.

Reports to: President, Kawartha Nordic (liaises with Director of Trails)

## **Responsibilities:**

- prepare ski trails for skiing using Pisten Bully snowcat or snowmobile grooming equipment
- ensure that trails are skiable and safe in a timely fashion; trails to be groomed before 9am
- update Day lodge attendant as to trail conditions for communication to skiers
- help with signage and marking of trails
- clear fallen trees and other obstacles from trails to facilitate grooming
- work with the Director of Trails to ensure efficient use of time and resources
- communicate problems/concerns to the Director of Trails
- work as a team member for special events and races

## **Qualifications:**

- Experience operating a Pisten Bully snowcat groomer (or similar heavy equipment)
- Experience operating chainsaw and snowmobiles
- Ability to work as a team player in a volunteer-based organization
- Knowledge of equipment maintenance an asset

- Standard hours of work: average 20 hrs/week (will vary depending on weather and grooming requirements)
