JOB NOTICE

The Kawartha Nordic Ski Club (KNSC) is a Nordic ski area located in North Kawartha township, Peterborough County, Ontario. Founded in 1976, Kawartha Nordic offers over 40 kilometres of groomed classic and skate trails, as well as 10 km of snowshoe trails through scenic, Canadian Shield wilderness. KNSC is a not-for-profit organization, governed by a volunteer board of directors, and offers numerous programs and events.

The Kawartha Nordic Ski Club (KNSC) is seeking applications for a part-time **Day Lodge Attendant** with the club. This is a contract position for the 2020-2021 season (December 2020 to March 2021) to work on weekends and some weekdays if availability allows this.

Reports to: General Manager

Responsibilities:

- managing cash flow and register; emptying and stocking self-serve kiosk
- sale of day passes and rental equipment
- maintain safety of club facilities (e.g. snow shovelling of access points, stairs, deck, etc.)
- answer requests for information and rental reservations (e.g. telephone, in-person and email requests)
- daily and weekly cleaning and sanitizing of chalet/cabins including washroom facilities
- operation of wood stoves in chalet
- updating trail conditions and providing other announcements and club communications on webpage/Facebook/Twitter/email
- coordinating with groups (e.g. schools) that are using the facility
- create a warm, friendly and inviting atmosphere at the club
- act as an emergency contact for all club users

- Experience with cash management and point of sale devices
- Excellent customer service and communication skills
- Ability to work as a team player in a volunteer-based organization
- Ability to ski to trail-side cabins
