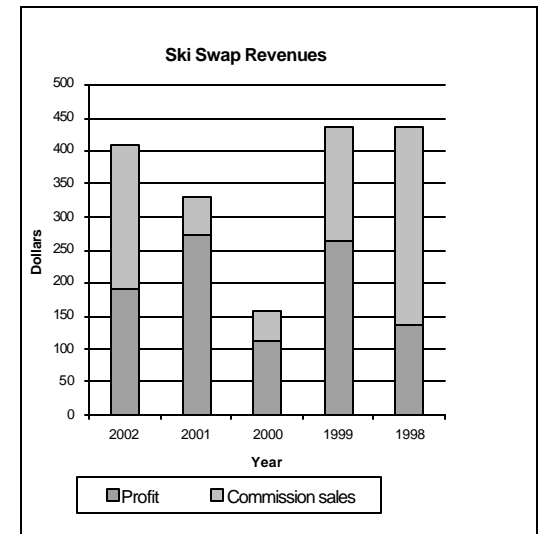

Trail adjustment at Cossar

To improve the flow of skiers in front of the Cossar Cabin, a through trail has been cut to the right of the ski racks.

This small adjustment allows skiers a clear path around the area where others choose to stop and put on or remove their skis. This will provide a safe, uninterrupted passage for skiers through a busy area.
