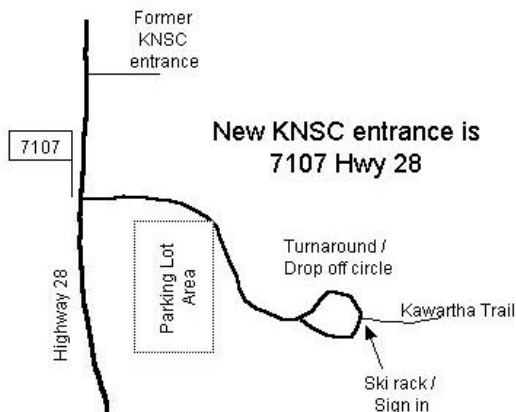

#### **New entrance and more parking on the Nordic Legacy Property!**

Look for the KNSC Logo sign and the "Nordic Ski Lane" road sign marking the entranceway to the new property (7107 Hwy 28). The driveway is wide enough to allow for two-way traffic, making entry and exit into our lot much safer. It will also accommodate angle parking for cars when needed. Proceed along the driveway until you reach the wide-open parking lot area. Park your car for a quick walk to the trailhead. Or, proceed to our new drop off / turn around circle to leave your equipment at the trailhead, then turnaround and park your car in the lot.

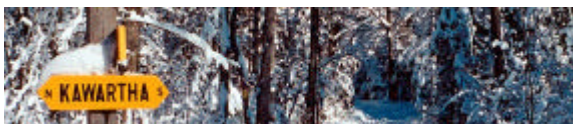

### **Trail Update**

Many hours have been put into trail maintenance and up grades this fall. **Thank you to all volunteers for your help.** Here is an outline of the additions and improvements. We hope that you will enjoy them.

1. The Kawartha, north of the Owl has been re-routed to the PL Road. Some may have skied this last year, when it became an alternate route due to flooding.
2. The Kawartha and Owl (N of their junction) have been joined by the new Otter trail.
3. A number of changes in trail names (Kawartha, Beaver & Trillium) should be noted on the new property.
4. The map also shows new trails on the new property. Some of these trails may not be ready for this winter.
5. Open and closed trails will be clearly marked.
