Nordic Legacy Campaign Phase II



What Is The Campaign For?

In an effort to enhance the facilities available to our growing membership, KNSC is building a beautiful two-story chalet and acquiring new property for trails.

Phase I (Nov. 04 – Oct. 06):

With your generous support, Phase I of the Nordic Legacy Campaign raised **\$101,500!** That exceeded our original goal of \$100,000 and helped finance the purchase of the property and the construction of the chalet. The total cost for the new property, chalet, entry road and parking lot was \$392, 733. Over the last couple of years, we have managed to raise \$243,200 through fundraising, club savings and the sale of the old property (including Cossar Cabin). The remaining \$148,800 has been borrowed from a variety of sources, at low interest.

Phase II (Nov. 06- Oct.07):

In Phase II of the Nordic Legacy Campaign, we are aiming to raise an additional **\$50,000** to help pay for these fabulous new facilities.

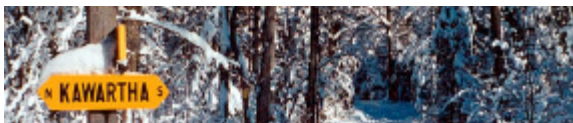
How does it Work?

New Ski Trails

The **Kawartha trail**, south of the chalet has now been connected to the Kawartha/Trillium junction. For many years this section was used as a snowmobile trail, which now follows a new route. For the most part, this section of Kawartha trail is where it was originally - first used for the Kawartha Tour in 1974... And ... the '**Haultain Hill**' is again part of our trail system.

New Snowshoe Trails

We are very happy to announce the opening of a new snowshoe trail. This exciting new trail takes in typical shield scenery winding through forest, over granite outcrops and beaver dams. **The trail, approximately 10km in length, begins at the new chalet and passes by the Laderach cabin.** The trails have been built with the financial support of the Atlas and Tubbs snowshoe companies as well as Wild Rock. The hard labour has been done by a number of the hardy souls from Wild Rock.
