Members have contributed close to \$60,000 to date towards our 350 acre land purchase project. Thank you!! Our goal is to raise \$100,000 of the \$190,000 cost prior to purchasing the property. Through our arrangement with Cross Country Canada, we can issue tax receipts for donations received by November 2006. We are encouraging members to donate again in the 2006 tax year because we will not be able to offer tax receipts past this year.
