New KNSC Map for 2005

KNSC is pleased to announce the arrival of the new 1.8km Trillium Trail. Two logging roads were connected to make this new trail. All GPS (Global Positioning System) readings have been completed, making the 2005 map the most accurate map to date. It is displayed in the Cossar Cabin. Some distances between junctions have been corrected. We have 30 km of groomed trails, including two dual-purpose loops (skating & classic), totalling 10.6 km and 9.6 km of wilderness trails.

Trail Changes

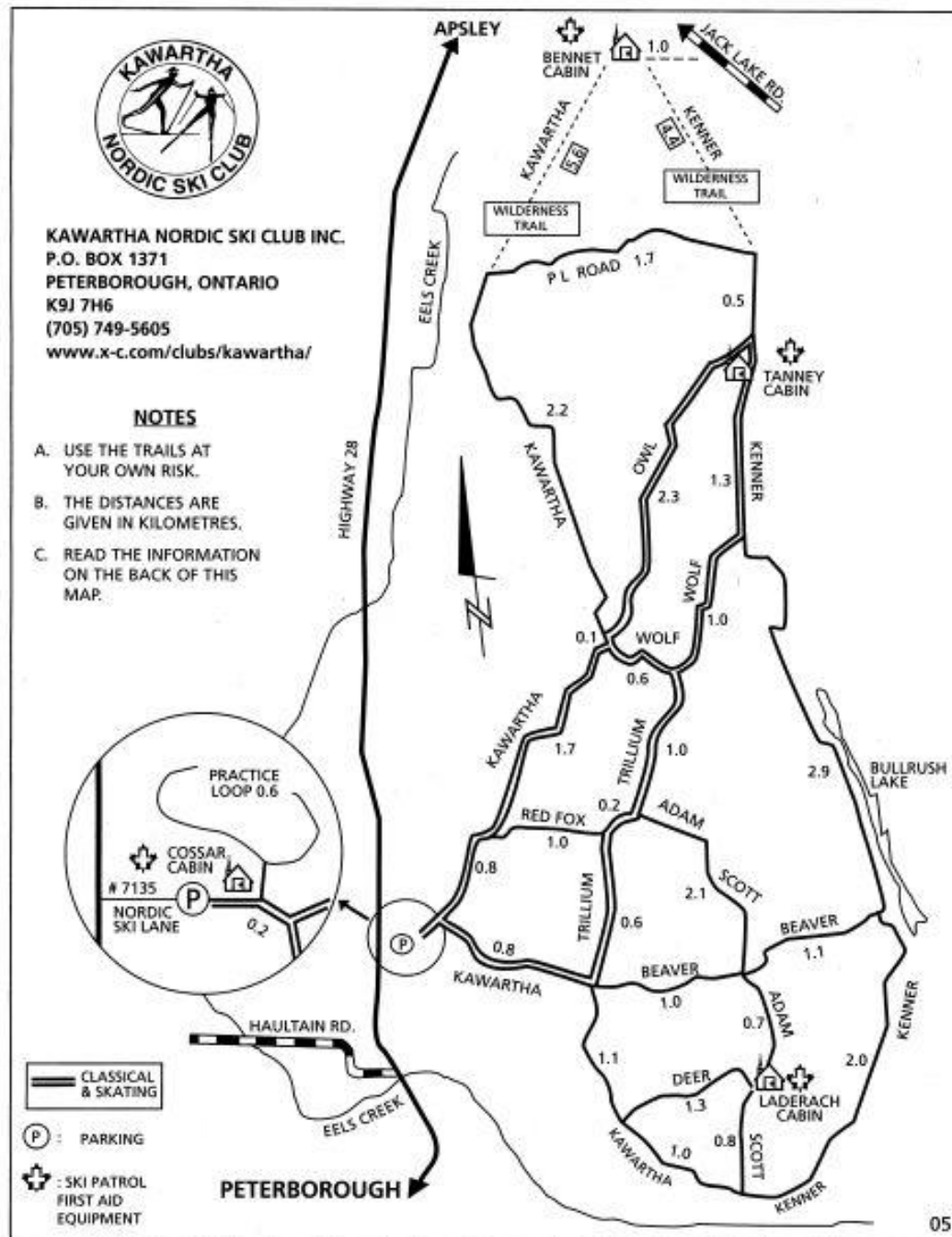
Our network of trails is constantly being improved to meet the skiing needs of our members and guests.

*The northern section of the Adam Scott has been closed. It had the roughest trail bed in the system. It was extremely hard on the grooming equipment. It would have required much time and money to improve.

*The northern end of the Adam Scott now ends/begins at the Trillium as does the eastern end of the Red Fox, a short distance (0.2 km) away.

*A portion of the Owl has been rerouted. The Kawartha/Owl junction is now 0.1 km north of the Kawartha/Wolf junction.
