## **Help Needed on the Chalet and Trails**

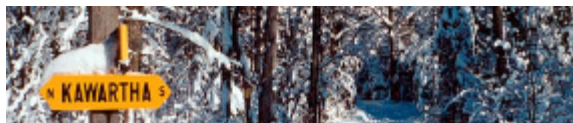
There are a variety of jobs still to complete on the Chalet and we would appreciate any help that people can provide.
